

Vaping Environmental Scan	<ul> <li>Review Environmental Scan Document</li> <li>Kortni's trial run with document:         <ul> <li>Conducted 8 trial scans during tobacco vendor education.</li> <li>Still did a scan of tobacco products, even when there were no vapes sold.</li> <li>Majority of the 8 stores had very small displays with exception of Dave's Party Store.</li> <li>Walkerville Kwik Mart had second most vapes available and more easily accessible than other stores.</li> <li>Shelby Wesco had least likely chance of vapes being stolen (by anyone) or seen by children.</li> <li>Chain stores (Dollar General, Family Dollar) do not carry vaping products and have the best signage letting people know the age to purchase and that they ID</li> </ul> </li> <li>Location Scan list - 21 locations still left to check. Some are probably closed for the season and there might be others on the list that don't have vaping products.</li> <li>Next Steps: Setup a time/date to do a couple of environmental scans with Kortni and then divide up remaining locations to complete.</li> </ul>
